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The HSC Foundation Announces New Chief Executive Officer
Dr. Nathaniel Beers will succeed Dr. Thomas W. Chapman as chief executive officer in 2017

Washington, D.C. (October 25, 2016) – The HSC Foundation Board of Directors Selection Committee is pleased to announce its selection of Dr. Nathaniel Beers, MD, MPA, FAAP, as President and CEO of The HSC Foundation effective May 1, 2017. The Selection Committee's decision has been approved by The HSC Foundation Executive Committee and Full Board.

Dr. Beers currently serves as The HSC Foundation's executive vice president of management and clinical affairs. In this capacity he is responsible for all professional services and programs system-wide. Dr. Beers holds a B.S. Degree from the University of Rochester, M.D. Degree from George Washington University's School of Medicine and Health Sciences and a MPA from Harvard University's John F. Kennedy School of Government.

Dr. Beers is also Board Certified as a developmental behavioral and general pediatrician. He has significant experience with management in health care and education and has strong skills in strategic planning and program implementation.

Dr. Beers will replace the current President and CEO, Dr. Thomas W. Chapman when he retires on April 30, 2017.
